New foster parents are required to participate in the following trainings, and **one other** of their choice, during their **first 15 months of service**. **Additionally, the training entitled "New Connections: Resources for Parents" is to be taken within the first three months of your initial license date.**

1. New Connections: Resources for Parents
3. Debriefing: Resources to be Gained from the Past Year's Experiences

Foster care parents who have served for a year or more and apply for a license renewal are required to have a minimum of six hours of advanced training. One of the options above can be utilized to meet this requirement. It would be a blessing to hear and learn from your past year's experiences. Other options can be approved that are offered outside of the CFC Parent University; please consult with your CFC caseworker.
