STRONG Families for Children

STRONG Families for Children is a prevention program that offers a secure and temporary home to children, minimizing the risk for abuse or neglect, and giving parents the time and tools they need to help their families thrive. This program provides short-term child care provided by vetted volunteer host families. STRONG stands for Sojourning Together Relying on God. *StrongFamiliesForChildren.org*



Family Care Learning is a service of CFC that provides online courses that help inspire confident parenting and cultivate safe, loving families. Mentors provide youth and adults a consistent presence in their life for at least four hours every month. Through these meetings, mentors are encouraged to support and guide their mentees even offering them prayer and sharing the love of Jesus. Our Pathfinders program is slightly different than our mentor program. A Pathfinder is a Christian willing to share their interests, talents, or hobbies with youth through a one-time, supervised Exploration Meeting.
